

TOWARDS A MORE HOLISTIC AND MULTI DISCIPLINARY EDUCATION



The Botany Laboratory provides plant identification services, noxious weed distribution information, and biological support data to the county agricultural Commissioner's offices, the general public, CDFA programs and various other State and Federal agencies.

2.3 Maths Lab

Physics Lab


5.) SPECTACULAR CONFERENCE HALL
